


### Dear Friend of St. Francis,

In November 2021, we were shocked and saddened by the loss of our friend and long-time supporter, Sheila Harrison. Sheila was a champion of St. Francis! She and her family volunteered on our campus, hosted our annual event, and helped us grow our program. After Sheila passed away, we, at St. Francis, searched for a meaningful way to honor her legacy. We reached out to her family and shared our dream with them – to grow our program with a building right next door!

And just like that — our dream became their dream. A beautiful new building with 6 additional 2-bedroom units right on our campus. The Harrisons have generously agreed to serve as general contractors for the project and have contributed the first \$250,000 needed to meet our \$1.5 million goal. Other community partners have gotten on board, and we are so grateful and honored to say that we have raised over \$1 million towards our goal! But we are not there yet. Homelessness doesn't just affect families who are grappling with it, it impacts us all. And this project -6 new units- will allow us to say, "yes" to more vulnerable families.

#### Sheila's Dream

Sheila's Dream will provide 6 two-bedroom, one bath, fully furnished apartment to provide safe, transitional housing for families with children in Marion and Polk Counties. The need for families in our community exceeds our current capacity and this project will allow us to serve more families. These apartments will be built adjacent to our existing 20-unit complex at 1820 Berry Street and will allow us to help even more families secure safe, stable housing in our community.
